All classes are academic but not textbook style. Using interactive and engaging content, these classes are socratic and student led, while still learning and developing. If your child is a non-traditional learner, if they need extra support due to difficulties with certain learning activities (such as reading or writing or organizing material), we will support them with compensatory and/or remediation strategies. #### **Catastrophes that Changed the World**

We will learn about catastrophic events that shifted our nation and the impact they had in the US and globally. While studying geography, weather, socio-economic factors, civics/government, reading, and writing, your students will be learning a tremendous amount while building their social awareness.

#### **Newscasting and Journalism**

Let's explore how journalists tell their stories via various forms of media. We will create news stories, retell old ones, and create our own journalistic journeys through print and newscasting.

### **Thursday Classes 11 am to 12:45 pm (8/20 through 10/8; 8 weeks) \$ 140/month**

#### **Forensic Science**

We'll learn how to search for clues, pay attention to details, tap into using our memory more efficiently, and learn about the science of collecting, preserving, and analyzing evidence. There will be made up crime scenes and reviews of details of actual crimes. Hands on science meets executive function and critical thinking in this class.

#### **Mock Court**
